

The Caring and Cost Efficient Way Forward.

In almost every State there is a growing population of long term patients from psychiatric hospitals, and elderly prisoners, with complex medical needs. SecureCare Options is the first specialized nursing home provider for hard to place individuals.

Working in collaboration with the State Departments of Mental Health and Addiction Services (DMHAS), Correction (DOC) and Social Services (DSS), SecureCare serves individuals who meet nursing home levels of care, transitioning from an inpatient level of care at DMHAS or from infirmaries at the DOC.

- Patients will likely have a range of serious and chronic medical conditions that may include dementia, stroke, paralysis and cancer.
- Some individuals may be dealing with other conditions such as Parkinson's, Huntington's or Multiple Sclerosis.
- Patients may be confined to wheelchairs or require walkers, or other adaptive devices for mobility.
 Financial savings are potentially enormous for DMHAS and DOC, with 50% reimbursement of services that the State is currently paying in prison infirmaries, through Federal Medicaid funding.

60 West – **Connecticut's** First Specialized Nursing Facility

Connecticut has taken the lead in supporting the development of a uniquely dedicated nursing home 60 West; designed exclusively to care for the growing population of long term patients from psychiatric hospitals and elderly prisoners with complex medical needs.

- Established in 2013, located in a quiet setting in Rocky Hill
- Dedicated solely to the provision of skilled nursing facility care for individuals referred by State Departments of Mental Health and Addiction (DMHAS) and Correction (DOC)
- 95 bed, CT licensed, chronic and convalescent nursing home
- Equipped, staffed and managed to ensure the health, safety and welfare of facility residents, visitors and staff
- CT recognized the need for more appropriate care, in terms of services and nursing skills, as well as more cost effective funding
- \bullet Funding 50% of care cost is through federal Medicaid reimbursement
