Working in collaboration with the State Departments of Mental Health and Addiction Services (DMHAS), Correction (DOC) and Social Services (DSS), SecureCare serves individuals who meet nursing home levels of care, transitioning from an inpatient level of care at DMHAS or from infirmaries at the DOC.

- Providing nursing facility care exclusively for physically, medically and cognitively infirm people whose conditions require SNF levels of care.
- Contracted and referred by State Departments of Mental Health and Addiction, and Correction.
- Medicaid and Medicare offset funding.

- Established in 2013, located in a quiet setting in Rocky Hill
- Dedicated solely to the provision of skilled nursing facility care for individuals referred by State Departments of Mental Health and Addiction (DMHAS) and Correction (DOC)
- 95 bed, CT licensed, chronic and convalescent nursing home
- Equipped, staffed and managed to ensure the health, safety and welfare of facility residents, visitors and staff
- Funding 50% of care cost is through federal Medicaid reimbursement
